

Ordinance No. 3 – Collection and Disposing of Garbage, Trash, and Other Refuse

Butman Township, Gladwin County, Michigan

WHEREAS, the Township of Butman having determined that it is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Butman Township that a sanitary means of collection and disposing of garbage, trash, and other refuse is required within the Township of Butman and to charge the owners and uses of such services therefor, and for that purpose adopt this Ordinance, as provided by PA 320 of 1927, MCL 123.241, et seq, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, the Township of Butman orders and enacts as follows:

1. That the reasonable and equitable annual charges for the services of collecting and disposing of garbage and refuse, including the administrative expenses incurred by the Township shall be determined by a Resolution of the Township Board, with due provision for the residential, commercial or other variations, such as vacant property and multiple ownership of properties, costs of collection, and alternative methods therefor. Such annual fee shall remain in effect from year to year absent action by the Township Board and shall be levied appropriately against each such parcel in the Township.

The Township Board may determine that all parcels are subject to this Ordinance if service is available thereto.

2. The Township Supervisor shall determine the residential, commercial or other units subject to this Ordinance according to the Resolution of the Township Board and shall assess against the subject premises the charges hereinto fore set forth, with the same to be collected, certified, assessed or returned, as a special levy upon the premises in the manner in which other taxes and assessments are levied within the Township and County.

3. The Township Treasurer shall establish upon the books of the Township a separate fund into which fund shall be paid all monies derived from such charges. Such fund shall be used to defray the Township's contract charges and other expenses incurred in administering the contract and in providing the service of collection and disposal of garbage and trash.

4. This Ordinance shall take immediate effect for the reason that the collection of such refuse and garbage is immediately necessary; a copy of this Ordinance shall be published in the Gladwin County Record within thirty (30) days of its adoption.
